This policy applies to

1. Early Years Register (EYR)
2. Childcare Register (CR) both parts

### Policy

A policy is a description of the setting’s aim / commitment. Consider the following information when detailing your policy.

- What is the aim / commitment of your behavior management policy, is it such as promoting acceptable behavior and respect for others?

### Procedure

A procedure is a description of the way in which a setting goes about a particular activity or process. Consider the following information when detailing your procedures.

- State the setting’s expectations of children and staff.
- State what support is available to staff, this could be training so staff can offer support directly or staff should be referring to external agencies / professionals.
- State step by step the setting’s behavior management strategies.

- State how the setting will deal with negative behavior that is not acceptable, such as bullying.
- How will the setting prevent and deal with bullying behavior?
- How are parents informed and consulted?
- State ways staff can encourage good behavior .
- Who is your named person with responsibility for behavior management issues?
- State when the setting will use physical intervention, you also need to consider the format in which you will record this and also how you have informed the parent or carer.
