## **FOREWORD**

In accordance with the two stage deposit process of development plan preparation, introduced by the Town and Country Planning (Development Plan) (England) Regulations 1999, the emerging Wigan Unitary Development Plan has been placed on deposit for objections at the First Deposit Draft (FDD) and Revised Deposit Draft (RDD) stages.

The document 'Local Plans and Unitary Development Plans – A Guide to Procedures' (paragraph 39) clarifies that the plan considered at the inquiry, and therefore also in this report, is the RDD. Objections which were made at the FDD stage, and which were not resolved by the RDD and unconditionally withdrawn, have been carried forward for consideration by the inquiry process.

This report is based on a 'skeleton report' provided by the Borough Council. This lists the representations made by those who objected to, or supported, the Unitary Development Plan at FDD and RDD stages. I have not altered the structure of this, but present notes to draw attention to objections which, while listed in one section of the skeleton report, are dealt with in another.
