NOTICE OF PROPOSALS

THE WIGAN BOROUGH (PASSAGEWAYS TO THE REAR OF 14 TO 26 ARGYLE STREET AND SIDE OF 20 TO 22 ARGYLE STREET, THE SIDE/REAR OF 16 TO 26 FRANCIS STREET AND THE SIDE/REAR OF 2 TO 20 WILLIAM STREET, HINDLEY) GATING ORDER 2008

Notice is hereby given that the Wigan Borough Council intends to make the above Gating Order under Section 129 of the Highways Act 1980 (hereinafter called 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers

The effect of the Order will be to restrict at all times, subject to certain exemptions, the public right of way over the passageways:-

- (i) To the Rear of 14 to 26 Argyle Street
- (ii) To the Side of 20 to 22 Argyle Street
- (iii) To the Side/Rear of 16 to 26 Francis Street
- (iv) To the Side/Rear of 2 to 20 William Street

Details of the exemptions and alternative routes along with full particulars of the passageways affected are set out in the proposed Order shown in the Schedule.

Any representations or objections to the Order must be in writing to the Director of Legal and Property Services, Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan WN1 1YN by quoting reference DPLS/BD/Q41/70-/Q-000899 by 20th February 2008. Please state the grounds on which they are made.
