NOTICE OF PROPOSALS

**THE WIGAN BOROUGH (PASSAGEWAYS AT WALTHEW LANE, SYDNEY STREET
AND NEVILLE STREET, PLATT BRIDGE) GATING ORDER 2008**

Notice is hereby given that the Wigan Borough Council intends to make the above Gating Order under Section 129 of the Highways Act 1980 (hereinafter called 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers.

The effect of the Order will be to restrict at all times, subject to certain exemptions, the public right of way over the passageways:

1. to the rear of 152 to 192 Walthew Lane
2. between 178 and 180 Walthew Lane
3. to the rear of 53 to 83 Sydney Street
4. to the rear of 92 and 94 Neville Street

Details of the exemptions and alternative routes along with full particulars of the passageways affected are set out in the proposed Order shown in the Schedule.

Any representations or objections to the Order must be in writing to the Director of Legal and Property Services, Town Hall, Library Street, Wigan WN1 1YN and quoting reference DLPS/KAS/Q41/125-/Q-1001 by 15th April 2008. Please state the grounds on which they are made.
