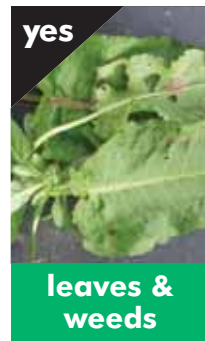
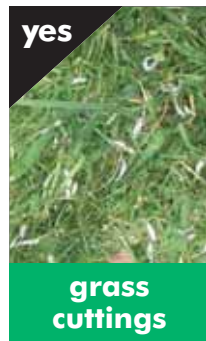
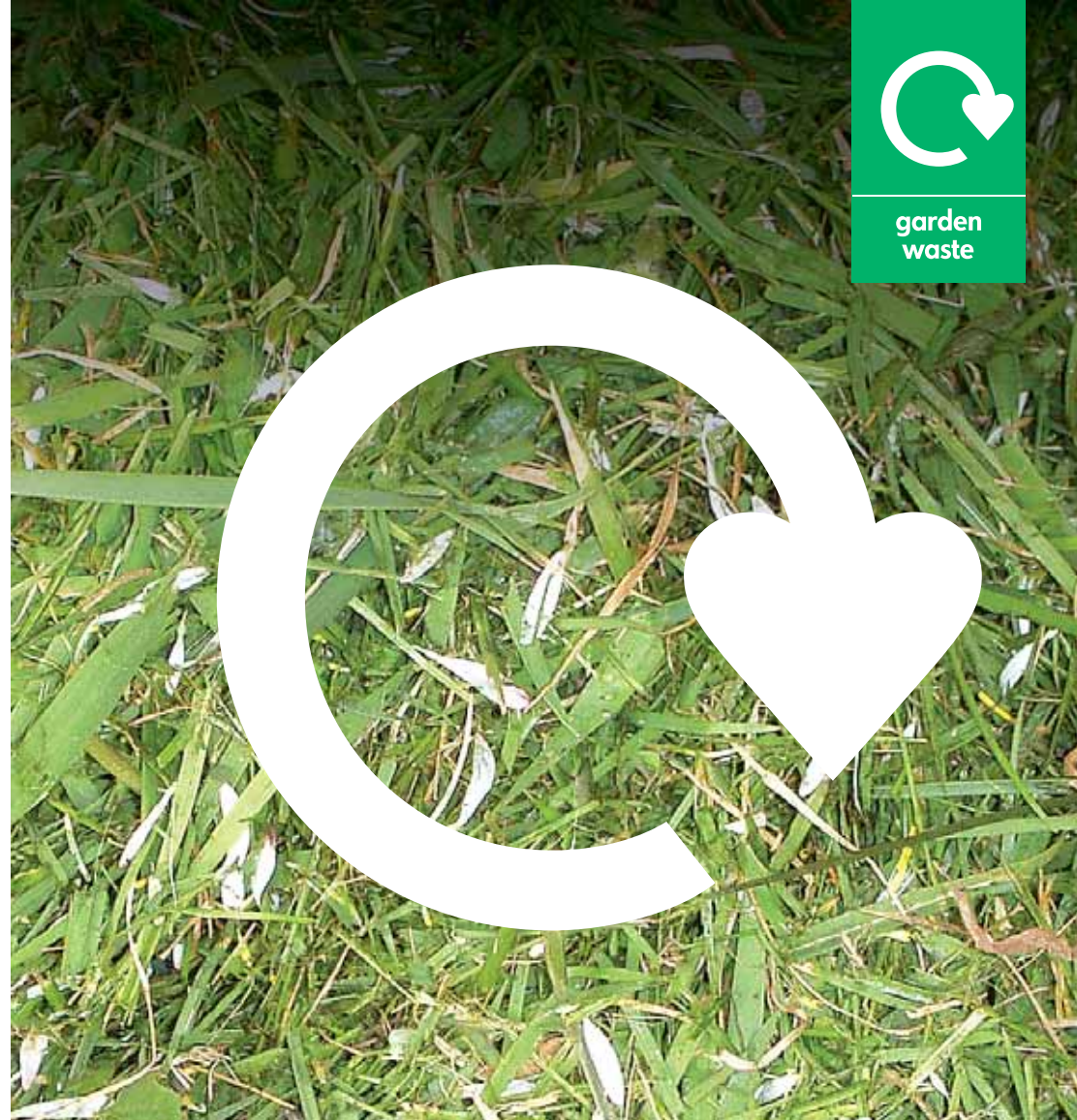

The garden waste experience

5 The composted material is spread onto farm land and used as a soil conditioner.



1 These materials can be put into your green bin.



2 Please do not place food packaging, plastics, bin liners/bags, cereal boxes, soap powder boxes, food waste, timber or rubble in your green bin.

4 The garden waste is bulked up and shredded before being taken for composting on a local farm.



3 If you place anything in your bin other than grass clippings, hedge clippings, small branches, weeds, plants, leaves, flowers and clean corrugated brown cardboard then your bin will not be emptied.
