Notes on data

1. It is ONS policy to publish population estimates rounded to at least the nearest hundred persons. Estimates are provided in units to facilitate further calculations but they cannot be guaranteed to be as exact as the level of detail implied by these figures. We request that data are rounded to the nearest 100 if quoted in any publication, documentation or similar.
2. Local estimates are now calculated by single year of age; but these figures are less reliable and we advise that single year of age data for local areas should be aggregated to at least five-year age groupings for use in further calculations, onwards circulation, or for presentation purposes. (Splitting into 0 year olds and 1-4 year olds is an acceptable exception).
3. This information is being made available because ONS would be obliged to release it under the Freedom of Information Act 2005 and local authorities have found it helpful in the past. It should be considered purely as intermediate data which has been used in the estimation process, and not necessarily able to be used except as part of a larger series of estimates.
4. These estimates are NOT National Statistics. They do not meet the stringent requirements made of National Statistics data and are fit only for certain purposes. These include certain uses within population modelling and enabling understanding of population estimates.
