Hints and tips..

- Ensure you only put the correct materials in each bank so we can recycle as much as possible. For example only put green glass bottles in the green bottle bank.
- Always read any additional information displayed either at the site or on the banks themselves.
- Always take away any boxes or non-recyclables you have used to carry your recyclables and dispose of them correctly and safely.
- If any of the banks are full, please contact the phone number on the bank itself, or please contact the council on **01942 404364**.
- Please be considerate to nearby residents and only use the sites between 8.00am and 8.00pm. Thank you.
- If you experience any other issues at any of our sites, please contact us on the above number.

Thank you for your help recycling the borough's waste.

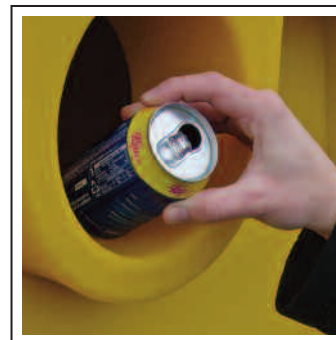
