The Children and Young People's Plan (CYPP) has been in place since April 2006. It includes 52 strategic priorities, representing all of the important areas for improvement currently being addressed by the organisations of the Children and Young People's Strategic Partnership (CYPSP).

In the light of local evaluation, and the 2006 Joint Area Review, a list of 18 "Partnership Priorities" has been identified. These will now provide the focus for partnership action, and will shape the monitoring and evaluation at CYPSP level. A list of the agreed partnership priorities, with cross-referencing to the 2006-09 CYPP document, is attached as Annex A.
