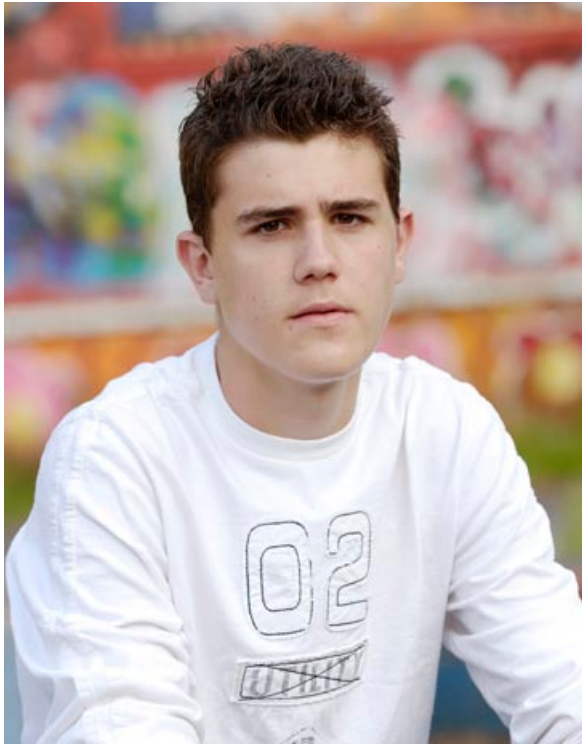

For young people

If you are:

- aged 13-18 years
 - at risk of unwanted/ unplanned pregnancy
 - at risk of sexually transmitted infections (STI's),
- then Barnardo's team can help you.

What we do

Meet you where and when you want to on a voluntary basis

How we do it

You will have your own worker who will meet you on a one to one basis, support you and give you information on other services, such as:

- Brook
- counselling
- YPDAT
- other health services.

Or just be there to:

- listen
- build trust
- share worries.

We will NOT share information about your sexual health, so long as you are over 13 years of age and we believe you understand your choices, unless we are concerned that you or someone else is at risk of harm, in which case we will try, where possible, to talk to you before we talk to anyone else.



For agencies and professionals

We welcome referrals from ALL agencies. Referral forms can be obtained via email, post, fax or by contacting a member of our team. Please see back of leaflet for details.

We will identify and deliver bespoke programmes of evidence-based sexual health and relationship education (SRE) – one to one, small group work and drop in sessions.

We pro-actively promote and support timely access to contraception and sexual health services. We equip young people with the skills to make informed decisions.
