

## The Crichel Down Rules Trace of Former Owners



Properties 19, 21, 25, 27 and 31 Mount View, Ince, Wigan are surplus to the requirements of the Council and will be put forward for disposal.

The Crichel Down Rules recommend in certain circumstances that surplus land and property be offered back to former owners or their successors in title at open market value and Wigan Borough Council is now trying to trace the former owners or their successors.

The properties are:-

- 19 Mount View, Ince acquired by Secretary of State for Transport from James Geoffrey Ellis and Christine Ann Ellis in July 1994
- 21 Mount View, Ince acquired by Secretary of State for Transport from John Brian Barker and Irene Barker in September 1991
- 25 Mount View, Ince acquired by Secretary of State for Transport from Gordon Wilkinson and June Marjorie Wilkinson in October 1989
- 27 Mount View, Ince acquired by Secretary of State for Transport from Perry Waring and Dorothy Waring in July 1992
- 31 Mount View, Ince acquired by Secretary of State for Transport from Malcolm Sabin and Susan Sabin in December 1992

The above owners in each case, or if deceased, their successors in title, are invited to register their interest in the respective properties. Such interest should be registered either in person or through solicitors or agents, no later than 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2008 by writing to: -
