Building Notice for the Replacement of windows, rooflights and certain doors to dwellings.



Places Directorate: Economy, Waste and Infrastructure

You can use this notice to notify us of your intention to install replacement windows, rooflights and external doors, which are doors with at least 50% of the inner surface glazed. But, if your contractor is registered with the **FENSA self-certification scheme**, that contractor may certify that the work complies with the relevant regulations and you will not need to notify us.

7 Statement

Your installer should be able to advise you on these matters.

I have read the attached guidance notes and I confirm that:

- a The replacement will achieve a U-value of $1.6\text{w/m}^2\text{k}$ for pvc or timber frames, or $1.6\text{w/m}^2\text{k}$ for metal frames or WEF Energy Band C.
- b Glazing within critical locations will be replaced with safety glass.
- c Existing measures for background and natural ventilation will be retained.
- d Existing measures for means of escape from relevant rooms will be retained.
Note: If the window pattern is to be changed this may affect means of escape.
- e Open flue appliances affected by the window or door replacement will be checked for adequacy of combustion air supply by a suitably qualified person.
- f If necessary, a suitable means of support will be provided above the replacement window or door.
- g Where the dwelling was required to be constructed to provide an easily accessible threshold at entrance doors that will be retained.
