

Visual Architectural Dictionary - Typical Interwar Properties (324, 326 & 328 Wigan Lane)



Red ridge tiles

Tall slender chimney stack

First floor windows adjoining eaves with no masonry above

Rendered first floor

Hipped tiled roof

Bay window supported on timber brackets

Overhanging roof protecting deep timber eaves and bay windows

Vertically proportioned casement window with transom window above

Stained glass transom

Gabled roof

Timber barge boards

Timber brackets supporting gabled roof

Gable finished in timber and render with simple geometrical shape

Finial

Roman arch to entrance


Recessed weather porch

Arched doorway with fan light above and lights to each side

Mature front garden

Bow window

Garden wall and gate piers finished in similar brick to ground floor of facade with privet hedge behind
