THE WIGAN BOROUGH (PASSAGEWAYS AT BATTERSBY STREET, LINGARD STREET AND CHAPEL STREET, LEIGH) GATING ORDER 2011

Wigan Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Section 129A of the Highways Act 1980 and all the enabling powers being satisfied that a Gating Order would be beneficial for tackling crime and anti-social behaviour to that area of Leigh hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Wigan Borough (Passageways to the rear of 2 to 28 Battersby Street, the rear of 1 to 27 Lingard Street and the rear of 121 to 133 Chapel Street, Leigh) Gating Order 2011 and shall come into operation on 5th October 2011.
2. The public right of way along the following passages as shown for identification purposes only on the attached plan is restricted at all times:-
 - (i) the rear of 2 to 28 Battersby Street, Leigh
 - (ii) the rear of 1 to 27 Lingard Street, Leigh
 - (iii) the rear of 121 to 133 Chapel Street, Leigh
3. Nothing in article 2 of this Order shall apply to:
 - a) all owners and occupiers of premises adjacent to or adjoining the passageways listed in Article 2
 - b) persons using the highway in connection with the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal in or near the said length of highway of any sewer, main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or any other telecommunication apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984
 - c) persons using the highway for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes
 - d) Council officers on business
 - e) persons using the highway with the permission or at the direction of the duly authorised officer of the Council
4. Alternative routes are available via Battersby Street, Lingard Street and Chapel Street, Leigh
5. Gates will be installed at the approximate locations marked on the attached plan and each will be operated and maintained by the Council.

6. The maintenance and operation of the gate will be the responsibility of the Council's Anti-Social Behaviour Co-ordinator who may be contacted at the Environmental Services Department, Civic Buildings, New Market Street, Wigan WN1 1RP.
7. The conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Highways Act 1980 have been complied with for the purposes of making the Order
