

Safeguarding; a Shared Responsibility (Level One)

Aims

To outline ways in which people can work together effectively to safeguard children and young people from harm, abuse and exploitation. Participants know what actions to take to respond to concerns to effectively safeguard and promote children and young people's welfare.

- Develop an understanding of safeguarding & promoting children's and young peoples welfare;
- Have a knowledge of the categories of abuse and awareness of the indicators of abuse;
- Understand safeguarding is everyone's responsibility;
- Know what to do if you are worried a child is being abused;
- Understand how, when and why to share information.
