1. A dependent child is a person aged 0-15 in a household (whether or not in a family) or a person aged 16-18 who is a full-time student and in a family with parent(s).
2. For the Census, part-time is defined as working 30 hours or less a week. Full-time is defined as working 31 hours or more a week.
3. A lone parent household with dependent children is here defined as a household consisting of a lone parent with at least one dependent child (and with or without non-dependent children) living as the only family in a household with no other person. This is the same as in most household composition tables, but is to be distinguished from tables on lone parent families where there may be other families or people living in the household.
