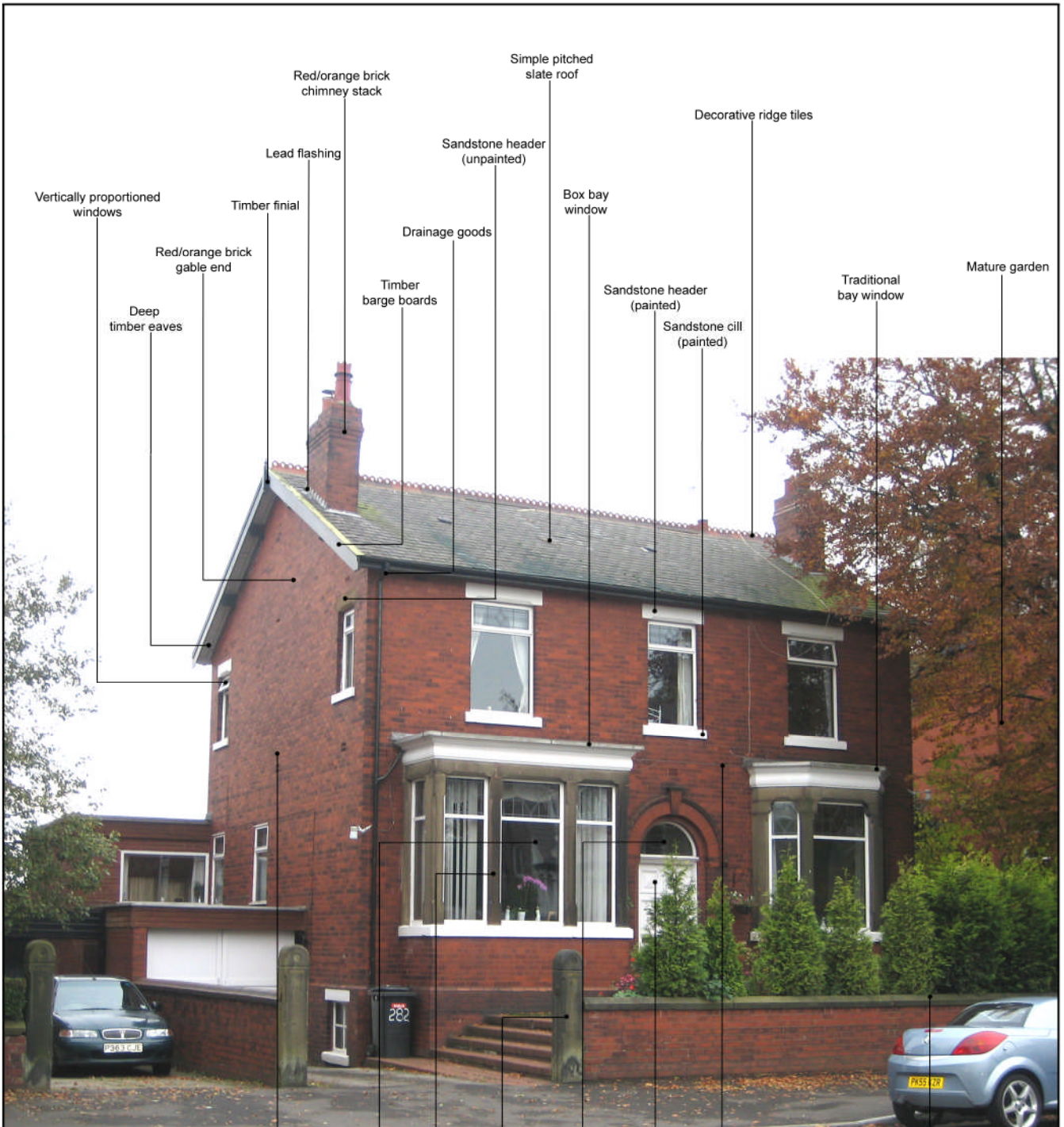



Visual Architectural Dictionary - Typical Late Nineteenth Century Property (282 Wigan lane)
