Child Access Criteria

Criteria- checked on receipt of EYInc5, Request for Early Learning and Childcare Team Service Involvement- Child Health Services; <i>is required to action the Entry to Portage Visit</i>	1.	Resides in the Wigan Borough
	2.	Under 3 years of age [at the time of referral]
	3.	If attending a setting this is less than 10 hours Early Years Provision
Criteria 4 & 5 are ascertained during the Portage Initial Visit <i>allocation in order of date received</i>	4.	Has two or more areas of additional need
	5.	Parents want Portage and want to engage
Additional Criteria 6- 11: <i>apply if there is a waiting list</i>	6.	Has not previously accessed Portage intervention
	7.	Child in Need
	8.	Life Limiting condition
	9.	Youngest child re optimum impact; early intervention/ prevention
	10.	Requires support in all four developmental areas on Entry to Portage. <i>NB: little or no progress being made</i>
	11.	Less than two specialist agencies involved

Child Exit Criteria at end of 4 Blocks of Portage support

<p>Criteria to be considered following each Portage block review. Portage Worker will share at ESKW/Portage supervision so that next steps can be considered. Exit will happen should 1 or more criteria be met.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Portage Targets are met. 2. 4 blocks of Portage visits have been accessed. 3. Child accessing 2 Year Old Funding at a setting for 10 hours Early Years Provision. 4. Child reaches 3 years of age and accesses Nursery Education Grant. 5. Child moves out of area [Wigan Borough] 6. Parents are not engaging with Portage delivery.
<p>Outcome from ESKW/Portage supervision</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Exit Portage. 2. Opportunity for consolidation for agreed period of time then reconsider access to Portage Service. 3. Continued access to Portage Service.
