If you have enjoyed walking to school during International Walk to School Week, it does not have to stop there! Your school can develop a School Travel Plan.

A school travel plan is a document which sets out a number of practical ways to reduce the number of car trips made to a school, to encourage more walking and cycling and to improve safety on the school journey.

The way to create your school travel plan is by logging onto <https://modeshiftstars.org/> and registering. A notification will then be sent through to our team who can approve the request. Then you will be informed by email that you are ready to get started! We have already paid for all schools in the Wigan Borough to have this scheme, therefore you are able to use it for no charge to yourselves.

Modeshift STARS is supported by the Department for Education and is a nationally accredited scheme. As you enter your school's data and achievements into the system, it automatically creates your school travel plan for you, saving a lot of time. The more travel initiatives your school do then the better the award you achieve. First you achieve bronze, then silver, then gold award.

Usually a member of staff at your school will be the assigned school travel plan officer to enter the data online and they can work with the school council to involve the whole school in the different initiatives.
