

Application for Targeted Individual Support 1

Target Support Worker visits and or funding will be allocated to an individual child and their setting using the following criteria:

- The child has been referred into ELCC and has an EYINC 4 in place
- An initial assessment EYINC 5 has been completed by a member of the ELCC Inclusion team
- The criteria for TIS 1 support has been met – TIS 1 will be allocated to those children who are working 2 ages bands or more below expected in one or more of the 3 EYFS prime areas (PSE, C&L, PD) and is accessing or eligible to access 2 or more specialist agencies
- Visits will be offered on a weekly, fortnightly, monthly, half termly or termly basis.

The frequency of the visit will be determined by the following:

- The degree of developmental delay within the EYFS using the child's chronological age as the benchmark
- The child is attending for their full nursery education grant entitlement or for at least 3 sessions a week
- Level of attendance at the setting, if below 75% further discussions with the setting would need to take place prior to allocation
- The frequency of visits will be reviewed each half term via the TSW reports, data submitted to the LA and IPM feedback from the individual setting

Additional funding maybe considered at the discretion of ELCC.

Settings must attend IPM's each half term to discuss the child's progress
