Capping "formal" social care cost at 2011/12 level.

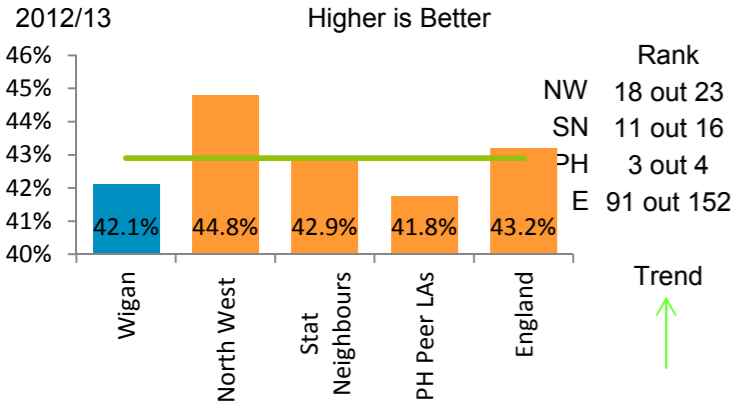

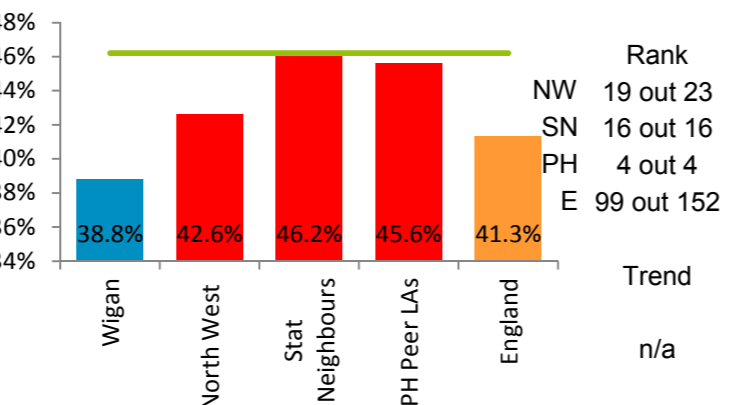

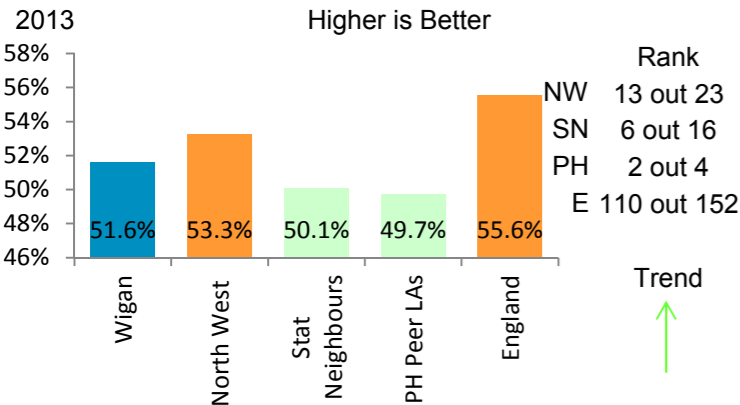
PHOF 1.18i - Social Isolation: % of adult social care users who have as much social contact as they would like.



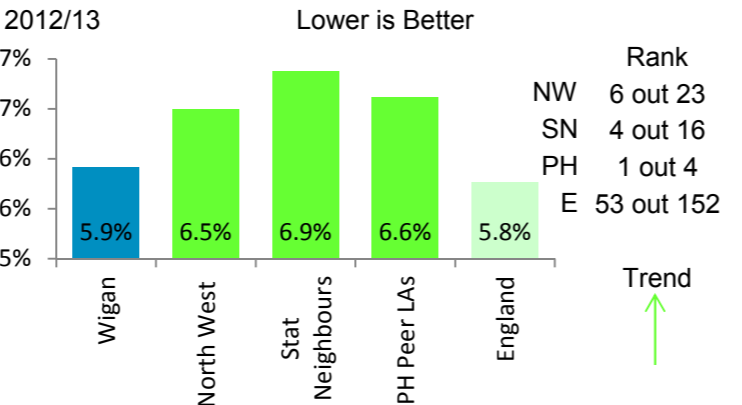
PHOF 1.18ii - Loneliness and Isolation in adult carers.



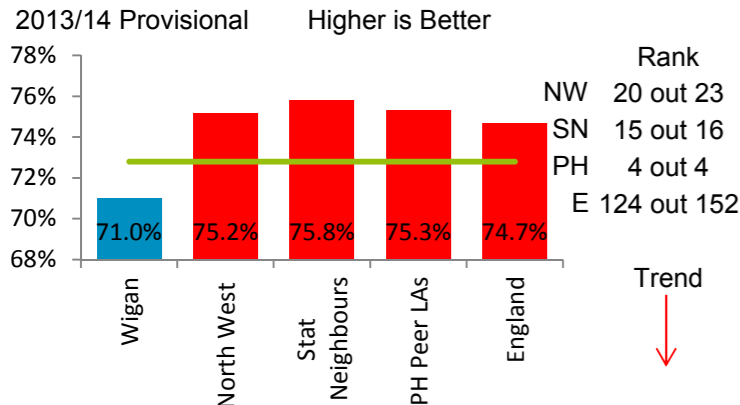

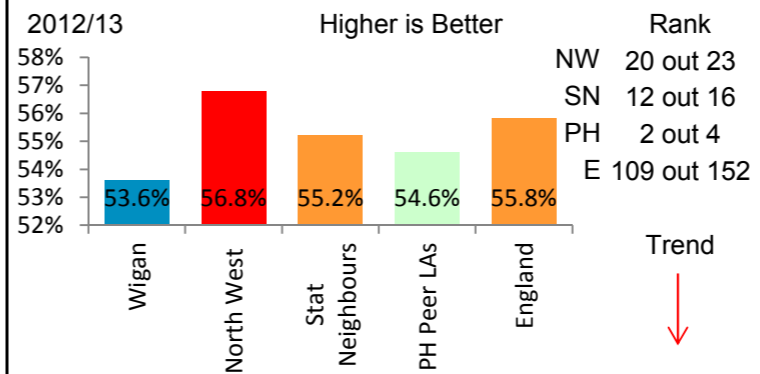

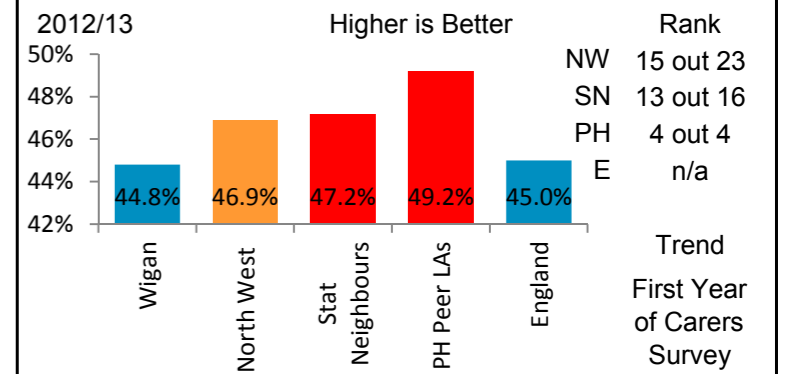

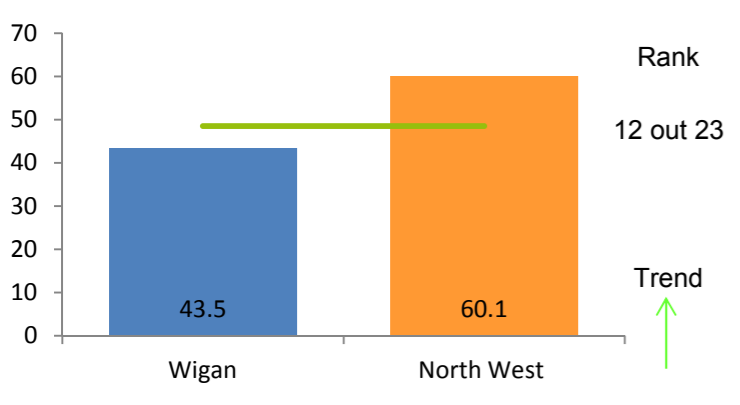
