Overview of the area

- Abram and Platt Bridge have a combined resident population of 15,505 which represents 4.9% of the total Wigan resident population of 319,700. Abram and Platt Bridge has a low proportion of residents aged 65+ with 13.6% of the population of pensionable age. Significantly lower than the borough average of 17.6%
- 9.3% of households are aged 65+ and live alone compared with 11.7% of the borough households.
- Half of the communities with Abram and Platt Bridge are ranked within the top 20% most deprived in England. These communities include: Woodcock Drive, Platt Bridge North, Platt Bridge North East, Bickershaw and Warrington Road.
- 18.3% of residents claim out of work benefits, above the borough average of 15.9%.
- The health of residents within Abram and Platt Bridge is slightly worse than the Wigan average with 7.6% of residents within the community describing their health as 'bad' or 'very bad' compared with the borough average of 7.1%.
- 62% of residents either own their homes outright or have a mortgage, 20% of households live in social rented accommodation.
- Abram and Platt Bridge can be accessed via a number of bus routes such as Wigan to Leigh (658) and Wigan to Warrington (360) and during peak times the longest wait between the 2 buses would be 25 minutes..
- Platt Bridge Library has 1 regular volunteer, The volunteer works 1 hour a month. There are 14 PC's that on average are used by 229 people per month.
