Activities in the stationary technical unit

The Company wishes to install a new biomass heating system at its distribution centre in Wigan. The current heating system is supplied to the offices with 2no. 30 kW gas-fired combination boilers. The warehouse/ distribution centres have no functioning heat provision. The alternative to a new biomass system would be to service and re-commission numerous existing gas-fired heaters.

Suppliers have recommended a Gilles HPKI-K 700 kW moving grate type boiler.

The proposed system would supply waste heat to the larger warehouse via 10no. 50 kW overhead multi-directional fan coil radiators and to the smaller warehouse via 9no. 25 kW fan coil units. The offices would be connected via plate heat exchangers to the existing central heating with 2no. domestic hot water cylinders for hot waters. An additional cylinder would be installed in the warehouse toilets to provide portable showers. The Premium Inn and Portacabin office units in the warehouse would have small convector heaters installed. The existing tap storage area would be used for the plant room with the wood shredder and fuel store situated adjacent to it on the exterior of the building.

Boiler feedstock is clean waste wood packaging (class A, B) produced by the distribution centre's activities. This wood will be shredded in a hogger to 20mm. A waste wood buffer tank is proposed to store up to 5 days of waste wood. If there isn't sufficient amount of waste wood, biomass will be stored from the Biomass Supplier List (BSL). Virgin wood chip will be used to start the boiler. A draft procedure has been produced which explains the controls and mitigation measures.
