<p>I am writing to make a request under the Freedom of Information Act for information to temporary housing provided the council. Specifically, I would like the following information:</p>		
<p>1) The number of people who have been housed in temporary accommodation, who made homelessness or emergency applications in each of the past five years. Please provide a breakdown for each year.</p>		<p>1<sup>st</sup> April 2019 – 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 = 269            1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 – 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021 = 718            1<sup>st</sup> April 2021 – 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 = 842            1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 – 1<sup>st</sup> Nov 2022 = 537</p> <p>(Please note this is households placed under a statutory temporary accommodation duty, we are unable to provide data prior to April 2019 due to a changes in our recording system)</p>
