 - 3) 4 went into Council tenancies.
 - 1) June 2021 6 assessments
 - 2) 6 were from Custody
 - 3) 4 went into Council tenancies, 1 returned to custody and one remained with family/friends.
 - 1) July 2021 3 assessments
 - 2) 3 were from Custody
 - 3) 2 went into Council tenancies and 1 remained with family and friends.
 - 1) Aug 2021 4 assessments
 - 2) 4 were from custody
 - 3) 4 went into Council tenancies
 - 1) Sep 2021 1 assessment
 - 2) 1 from custody
 - 3) 1 went into Council tenancy
 - 1) Oct 2021 2 assessments
 - 2) 1 from Custody and 1 from Hospital
 - 3) 2 went into council tenancies.
