

 Does your Local Authority operate a Rent Deposit Scheme (financial support to residents to help them access accommodation in the private rented sector)? Wigan Council has operated a Deposit Assistance Scheme since August 2020, whereby we provide a non-cash deposit (or bond) to the landlord on behalf of the tenant, to be claimed against in the event of any damage, or losses to, the property. The bond does not cover rental arrears.

Financial support i.e. cash deposits are only considered for vulnerable persons/specific cohorts such as care leavers, ex-offenders, persons fleeing domestic abuse and move-on's from temporary accommodation (this list is not exhaustive), when the standard bond offer is not acceptable or suitable.

b) When financial support is provided, there is no expectation of repayment from the tenant. Provisions have been made however to ensure that the rental deposit returns to the Council upon the end of the tenancy (minus any deductions/claimed sums).

As above, the Council's lead offer is the non-cash bond.

There were no loans/grants paid under the scheme from 2018-2022, as cash deposits have only been available from this financial year 2022/23.
