#### My suggestion

- 1.Around Ashton Library which is the start of the Bryn Ward on wigan rd left side as your coming out of Ashton towards Bryn. Tus would need polls arecting as for some reason it has never had a welcome sign although this is the main route to our ward. Please note the right side of the road is Ashton ward only on one side of the street. I am happy to meet for this one the following are just replacements. This could even be put in the grounds of the Library.
- 2. Coming into Bryn off the motorway marus bridge roundabout at top end of Wigan rd
- 3. Lowbank rd near the motorway bridge
- 4. Downall green rd as you enter St Helens Council at the bend before it becomes Lowbank rd

Good morning Councillor Jones

Could I please confirm that the four locations mentioned are the ones pictured (attached) and confirm the request:

- 1 request for boundary sign at library as attached (Ashton Library Boundary Sign) As you can see, the library grounds are not adopted highway managed by this service, this would need permission from land owner and possibly require funding from brighter borough. This financial year budget would likely not stretch to this however works would be issued to our sign shop at Makerfield Way to carry out the works should budget be confirmed.
- 2 Request for Boundary sign to be replaced? Maps shows that one is already in place here, is it missing? (Bryn 3 Sisters boundary sign) attached image from May 2021.
- 3 Replacement Boundary sign as this one is showing missing on maps (Low Bank Road near motorway bridge boundary) attached image from November 2021.
- 4 Request for Boundary sign to be replaced? Maps shows that one is already in place here, is it missing? (Downall Green Road bend before Lowbank Road boundary) attached image from May 2021.

Budgets for replacement signs that do not require poles and complete installation as they would be attached to prior installed poles should be ok to progress once we have confirmed the above. This will be discussed further in a Traffic meeting which takes place on Wednesday and I will only be able to confirm once this meeting has happened. Please try to confirm the above today if possible.

We have had similar requests for new boundary signs as you enter Ashton on Golborne Road where the Golborne and Lowton West Boundary meets the Ashton Boundary which have been refused as we have been advised by the Department for Transport that a reduction in sign clutter is where we should be heading and not introducing more signs. All internal boundaries do not necessarily need signing and with limited resources it is difficult to provide signs at one location as this will then be expected in other requested locations and the cost is very high to do this.

I have measured the footway to ensure that enough room is available for a sign here which is on the boundary of Ashton and Bryn as the Ashton sign is which is located up next to Alexander Road. The original suggested location was for in front of the church which was understandably unfavourable and so this location has been chosen as a suitable and fair location where those travelling on the Southwest side of Wigan Road will be in the Boundary by the time they see the sign.
