

Request:

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I would like to know the following:

- 1) The number of charging points for electric vehicles installed by your local authority
- 2) The cost of installing these charging points

I would like data for each of the last three years, with a year-end March 31st 2023.

If you are unable to provide three years of data, please provide two years of data. If you are unable to provide two years of data, please provide one year of data.

Response:

Wigan Council has the following Charge Points, which were installed and funded through TFGM.

Sites for general public use as follows

Harrogate Street – Wigan

Water Street – Wigan

Mona Street - Wigan

Loire Drive – Wigan

Church Street – Leigh

Spinning Gate – Leigh

Lord Street – Leigh

Doctors Nook – Leigh

Leigh Town Hall – Leigh

(Please note the above site have 2 points for charging)

None of the above have been installed in the last 3 years. However, 3 sites namely Chatsworth Street, Loire Drive and Leigh Town Hall Car Park are in the process of 2 points being installed per site to allow taxis only to charge.

For detail with regards to cost of installing this will need to be sought from TFGM as all charge point were funded via TFGM.
