

Request:

If a person with a learning disability and/or autism, who is funded by your Authority, is in need of care (either in a care home or supported living) and a congregate setting (such as a village community) is considered by that individual and / or family or CoP Deputy to be the most appropriate setting based on assessed need, would you be prepared to agree to such a placement (assuming one is available) and - at least in principle - to support such a placement? If not, why not?

All cases are considered on an individual assessment basis, including a formal best interest process where required, aligned with statutory requirements.
