Under the Freedom of Information Act can you provide me with the relevant documentation that considered planning, the integrity of the conservation area and the viewpoint of the camera.

Response

The installation of traffic and speed cameras is not development as defined in the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, so neither full planning permission nor any approval pursuant to permitted development rights are required for their installation.
