Please find below a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act which relates to homeless provisions for families in Wigan.

1. Please provide a breakdown (by year) of the number of families (i.e. a parent or parents with one or more children under the age of 18 and including pregnant people) living in hotel-type accommodation - including B&Bs (as provided by the council) in the city of Liverpool over the last 5 and a half years starting from 1st January 2018 and up to 1st July 2023.
2. Of those in question one how many families were in hotel / B&B style accommodation where they did not have access to a private (not-shared with another household) bathroom, toilet or kitchen/cooking facility? (please break this down by year starting from 1st January 2018 and up to 1st July 2023.)
3. Of those in question two, how many families (starting from 1st January 2018 and up to 1st July 2023) were in this accommodation for:
  - less than 6 weeks
  - between 6 - 7 weeks
  - between 7 - 8 weeks
  - between 2 - 3 months
  - between 3 - 4 months
  - between 4 - 5 months
  - between 5 - 6 months
  - between 6 - 7 months
  - between 7 - 8 months
  - between 8 - 9 months
  - between 9 - 10 months
  - between 10 - 11 months
  - between 11 - 12 months
  - 12+ months
4. Of those in question one, how many families were in hotel / B&B accommodation where they did not have access to cooking facilities? (please break this down by year starting from 1st January 2018 and up to 1st July 2023.)
5. Of those in question four, how many families (starting from 1st January 2018 and up to 1st July 2023) were in this accommodation for:
  - less than 6 weeks
  - between 6 - 7 weeks
  - between 7 - 8 weeks
