- 1) Where is the rubble going to from the Galleries demolition site?
- 2) What is it being used for?
- 3) Why has it been deemed unsuitable for use on a canal towpath?

Response

Redundant building materials from the demolished structures are being used to set the levels for the new development, particularly in the basement which is being raised as part of the new works to provide customer car parking for the new development.

The balance of construction material is being crushed and graded into recycled 6F2 material for road construction etc. However, we do not currently hold the information about the end use.

In theory, the material is suitable for a footpath but it is not available as the credit has been accounted for within the agreed demolition contract, and remaining waste is being used as refuse derived fuel (RDF). Therefore, no material is available for canal towpath works.
