Please can you provide me with the amount of money that the council has spent on the climate emergency broken down annually for the last 4 years. To include:

On council vehicles, on council buildings, on social housing, other

Response

Council Fleet:

7 ULEV vehicles leased or owned by Wigan Council have been purchased in the last 4 years. 202021 – no vehicles ordered 2021/22 – 6 vehicles ordered at a total cost of £199,385 2022/23 – 1 vehicle ordered at a total cost of £6,494.76 on a 3-year lease

2023/24 – no vehicles ordered

Council buildings:

Wigan Council have utilised central government's Public Sector Decarbonisation Scheme to access grant funding to retrofit energy efficiency measures and low carbon heating systems on a number of Council corporate buildings. A certain amount of match funding has been allocated alongside this, and the figures for both match funding and grant funding are displayed in the below table with building reference.

Council Social Housing:

Council funds have been utilised on a number of decarbonisation measures on Council owned social housing within the past 4 years. These include:

Air Source Heat Pumps/Solar PV

Insulation

2020/21 - £2,566 2021/22 - £34,472.97 2022/23 - £0 2023/24 - £0

Expenditure for boiler replacements is also included below, as although this is a replacement of a fossil fuel heating system, old inefficient boilers are replaced with A rated gas condensing boilers which corresponds to a reduction in carbon emissions and energy savings for social housing tenants.

Boiler Replacement:

2020/21 - £1,113,777.65 2021/22 - £1,499,608.52 2022/23 - £1,686,506.56 2023/24 - £2,408,004.09

Other

There are no other direct decarbonisation measures that Wigan Council has spent money on, however there are a number of climate adaptation measures undertaken by the Council such as tree planting, flood risk prevention, traffic calming and active travel measures that would contribute towards emissions reductions.
