The data I would like to request is the following, for the financial years ending March 2019, March 2020, March 2021, March 2022, March 2023 and H1 of the 2024 financial year (April 2023 to September 2023).

- Supported living settings
- 3. The number of people discharged from:
  - Residential care settings
  - Supported living settings
- 4. The average weekly fee across all people supported in:
  - Residential care settings
  - Supported living settings (the portion of the fee relating to the care support)
  - Supported living settings (the portion of the fee relating to the housing support)
- 5. The average weekly fee across new placements only in:
  - Residential care settings
  - Supported living settings (the portion of the fee relating to the care support)
  - Supported living settings (the portion of the fee relating to the housing support)
- 6. The average weekly fee across discharged people only from:
  - Residential care settings
  - Supported living settings (the portion of the fee relating to the care support)
  - Supported living settings (the portion of the fee relating to the housing support)
- 7. The median time in days from referral (when the Local Authority issues a request for a placement) to placement (when the service user enters the care setting) in:
  - Residential care settings
  - Supported living settings

- Where the care setting is "in-area" (the local area covered by the Local Authority)
- Where the care setting is "out-of-area" (outside the local area covered by the Local Authority)
