

1) Please advise which schools in Standish have lollipop men/ women and where they do not when they were stopped?

There is an SCP on Preston Road, near Kenyon Road, which supports children attending Standish High School and St Marie's Catholic Primary School. Another SCP supports families crossing Rectory Lane and St Wilfrid's Road to attend St Wilfrid's C of E Primary School.

The SCP directly outside St Marie's Catholic Primary School has not been staffed for at least 3 years and has a road island to assist pedestrians crossing Avondale Street. The SCP that supported Wood Fold Primary School, on the junction of Almond Brook Road/Green Lane, has also not been staffed for at least 3 years and is supported by a puffin crossing. We do not hold the actual dates these crossings stopped having staff assigned to them.

2) Also how much does it cost to have a lollipop man/woman?

For the financial year 22/23 each 10-hour post cost £6,244.

3) Finally how much does it cost to have a zebra crossing outside a school or a pedestrian crossing?

A zebra crossing is approximately £8,000 and a puffin push button-controlled crossing is around £80,000.
