

I would like to request the following:-

1) The number of fly-tipping incidents reported to your council in 2020, 2021, and 2022, broken down by the number reported in each year.

2020 - 839  
2021 - 1593  
2022 - 3416

2) Total number of fines issued for fly-tipping by your council in 2020, 2021, and 2022, broken down by each year, and what the highest fine was in 2022

2020 - 86  
2021 - 96  
2022 - 41

The fixed penalty amount for an unauthorised deposit of waste in Wigan borough is £400 which is reduced to £200 if paid within 14 days

3) The location in your council territory which accumulated the most number of fly-tipping incidents in 2022 and how many incidents were reported there. By location, I mean a street, park, or any other public or private place.

Ormskirk Road, Wigan - 31 recorded incidents of fly tipping

Drummers Lane, Ashton - 31 recorded incidents of fly tipping

4) The amount of money spent by your council clearing fly-tipping incidents in 2020, 2021, and 2022, broken down by the amount spent each year.

A figure for the removal of fly tipping is not available. This is due to the fact that the Council's Parks and Streetscene service deploy a number of frontline teams to remove fly tipping, who also carry out other work within neighbourhoods, such as grounds maintenance work, litter picking and general cleaning duties.
