The details of the Residential Family Centres are exempt from disclosure under Section 38 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FoIA). Section 38 (i)(b) states that information is exempt information if its disclosure under this Act would, or would be likely to, endanger the safety of any individual. Disclosure under the FoIA is deemed to be to the world at large. To disclose the full details of these residential settings to the world at large would put at risk the safety of vulnerable individuals.

As this a qualified exemption, the Council is required to undertake a public interest test. The Council acknowledges its obligations of transparency and

accountability in all its undertakings. However, in this case, the safeguarding of vulnerable individuals would be put at risk by publishing the details of these residential settings and clearly outweighs that. On balance, therefore the Council believes that this part of your request is exempt under Section 38 of the Freedom of Information Act.
