

1. I would like to know which glyphosate-based herbicides are currently used by, or on behalf of, the council on Sites of Special Scientific Interest (SSSIs) that are owned by, managed by, or under the control of the council.
2. Please can you provide the data for the most recent 12-month period for which the information is available.
3. Please can you also specify the amount and brand of each glyphosate-based herbicide in question, as well as the size of the area over which they are used.

1. Round up ProBiactive

2. 0.5 litres in 12 months at Bryn Marsh and Ince Moss via Lancashire Wildlife Trust as managing organisation on behalf of Wigan Council

Glyphosate is only used on two occasions; to treat Giant Hogweed (health and safety concerns) and Japanese Knotweed (legally obliged to treat to prevent spread of invasive non-native species INNS).

No herbicide used Highfield Moss (council owned) in 12 month period

3. Glyphosate is used over an area approximately 5 hectares in size across Bryn Marsh and Ince Moss SSSI.
