

## Request:

- 1) GIS files (shapefiles or similar) of areas with critical drainage problems, or local flood risk zones ('wetspots/hotspots' or flood zone 3a,3b) as define by either the SWMP or SFRA or other measures.
- 2) Updated/ available current and previous reports and appendices of SWMP (Surface water management plan) or similar, SFRA (Strategic flood risk/ Consequence assessment), PFRA (preliminary flood risk assessment), LFRS (Local Flood risk strategy).
- 3) Copies of any Supplementary Planning Documents with regards to flood risk, drainage and climate change.
- 4) A copy of your flood risk assessment if you have one.

## Response:

The Critical Drainage Areas are under review and not currently available to share.

For shapefiles of the Environment Agency flood risk mapping you will need to contact the Environment Agency directly as the Council does not hold their records.
