

Request:

1. The list of providers that the council has contracted to provide domiciliary/home care since 2011, with the accompanying dates.

Response:

We cannot provide the requested information dating back to 2011; to gather this information would exceed 18 hours of finding time. We can however provide information dating back to December 2016 when, following conclusion of a procurement exercise via a call-off process from the first iteration of the Council's Ethical Framework, an award of contract for domiciliary/home care services was made to the following providers:

Allied, Ashwood Care, Care Choice North West, Bespoke, Carewatch Care Services, Cherish UK, Excel Care Management NW, Grade A Care, , Premier Care, PCS (Personal Care Services), Mayday Homecare, Harmony Homecare, Stocks Hall Care, Shaw

The contract period was 12/12/2016 – 31/03/2022.

Prior to the expiration of the homecare contracts in March 2022, a re-commissioning exercise was undertaken via a call-off from the second iteration of the Deal 2030 Care and Support Ethical framework which resulted in the following providers being successful in an award of contract for homecare services:

Ashwood Care, Excel Care Management, Harmony Homecare, Cherish UK, Elite Care NW, PCS (Personal Care Services) Ltd, Care Choice NW, Caring Connections Ltd.

The contract period runs from 01.04.22 – 31.03.27 with the option to extend to 31.03.29.

Wigan Council do not hold formal contracts with the care home that we support placement in to, both in and out of borough. Placements are made on a spot purchase basis with a Support Plan and a Letter of Intent.

2. The list of providers that the council has contracted to provide residential care since 2011, with the accompanying dates.

The accompanying spreadsheet has two tabs. The first detailing each of the in-borough care homes that we have placed in between 2011 and present date. The second tab is for the out of borough providers where we have placed people. This tab has the first year that we placed people into the service in Column B and the end year of Wigan placements. Where there is no end date in Column C this means we still have people placed in these services.
