- 1) Which, if any, tier 2 weight management services for Children and Young People aged 0-18, does the council currently provide funding for.
- 2) Please provide an overview of the services provided by, the service population of, and the referral criteria of each of these services.
- 3) How many children have been referred to these services within the calendar year 2022.
- 4) How much total funding was spent on these services within the calendar year 2022.
- 5) How much total funding was spent on these services within the calendar year 2018.

Response:

1) Tier 2 weight management is offered through the 'Let's Get Movin' programme aimed at children and their families.

2) Let's Get Movin' provides a health referral service for the population aged 2 – 17 year-olds who have a range of physical conditions and health needs.

The service is delivered within schools, nursery settings, leisure venues, Family Hubs and community venues and supports families to make healthy habits for life.

The Let's Get Movin' is provided by Be Well which is the Wigan Health improvement and leisure service.
