The data relates to LD supported living delivered by external providers. We are not able to separate the data to exclude those with only autism who do not have a learning disability.

*The vast majority of sleep rates are paid at the Council's ethical framework rate of £11.36 per hour. The £65 fixed rate (10 hours) is paid to only one provider (with 1 LD client) who pays a fixed sleep pay rate to staff and an enhanced pay rate for day support.
