For the last financial year what was the total income your authority collected from the following;

- Parking fees for town centre car parks
Parking Fees - Information is exempt under S31, due to the potential exposure to criminal activity based on the collection of cash. The greater the potential for a disclosure to result in crime, the greater the public interest in maintaining the exemption. The victims of crime can be both organisations and individuals and there is public interest in protecting both from the impact of crime.
