Financial Assessments undertaken to assess a person's contribution to care costs are completed by a multiskilled team of assessors, who do not exclusively deal with Financial Assessments but are also responsible for administering applications and claims for Housing Benefit, Council Tax Reduction, Blue Badge disabled parking permits and other work streams.

We are therefore unable to provide a financial annual cost for provision of Financial Assessments alone.
