Do you have an annual breakdown over the past 3 years of

- a) numbers of asylum seekers who are known to be homeless.
- b) b)estimates for the number of asylum seekers who will be homeless by the end of the year

Response:

 a) This is for cases who presented at Homeless as leaving Home Office Accommodation –

1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2020 – 31<sup>st</sup> Dec 2020 = 63
1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2021 – 31<sup>st</sup> Dec 2021 = 86
1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2022 – 31<sup>st</sup> Dec 2022 = 82
1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2023 – 27<sup>th</sup> Oct 2023 = 158
```

b) No estimate for all asylum seekers that will be homeless by the end of the year, but we've included the latest figures up to the end of October 2023 in part a of this response.
