Day Services are commissioned on an individual provider basis using an open book approach to understand fair cost of care. Rates are agreed as daily rates, not hourly rates.

Domiciliary Care: £19.44 per hour.

Residential Care (2-tier rates):

- Real Living Wage fee rates 13.9%.
- National Living Wage fee rates 11.1%.

Supported Living (wake support) 12.5%

Domiciliary Care: 11.2%

The council does not currently charge internally and therefore does not hold an hourly rate for in-house provision. This is operated within the local authority and operating costs vary.
