I wish to see minutes (or a council video) relating to the decision so I can understand HOW the decision was made.</p>	<p>Policy CP 12 was replaced on adoption of the Places for Everyone Development Plan Document on 21 March 2024 by policy JP-G8 in that plan. This can be viewed here: Places for Everyone Joint Development Plan Document (greatermanchester-ca.gov.uk) – appendix 1 refers.</p> <p>The mechanism was development plan review, i.e. the replacement of one by plan in whole or in part by another.</p> <p>It was approved by full council on 20 March 2024, which can be viewed on the council's website.
