We do not charge rent on a m2 basis, the charges are for a full / half plot and water (where available) is charged in addition to the rent.

- Standard with water - £98.00
- Standard without water - £84.00
- OAP concession with water - £56.00
- OAP concession without water - £42.00
- Admin charge - £20.00

Half Plot

- Standard with water - £49.00
- Standard without water - £42.00
- OAP concession with water - £28.00
- OAP concession without water - £21.00
