Wigan Council does not collect CIL (Community Infrastructure Levy), therefore no contributions have been received under this legislation. Wigan Council collects affordable housing contributions through Section 106 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

The Council's first preference for the delivery of affordable housing through Section 106, is for the affordable units to be provided directly on the site by the developer. In these instances, there is no financial contribution and so no details of these cases have been provided in the response.
