How do we apply to get on your approved suppliers list for lift repairs and modernisations? 	<p>The lifts within the council portfolio are serviced by RJ Lifts Ltd</p> <p>There are approximately 150 goods, passenger and platform lifts including a number of domestic through floor lifts within the portfolio.</p> <p>The current contract will expire at the end of October 2026 but is subject to a one year extension depending on the performance of the contractor which would extend the end date to October 2027</p> <p>The tender would be advertised on The Chest</p> <p>The Council does not have an approved list for contractors. The current contract covers all servicing and repairs. Any modernisations would be separate and would be tendered via The Chest on an individual basis open to any eligible contractors.</p>
