a. that your council currently operates these mechanisms and has a strategy to cover CSE

We have a multi-agency Daily Governance Meeting led by our Multi-Agency Complex Safeguarding Team to respond quickly to CSE concerns. We also have a monthly high-level partnership oversight panel for children of highest concern and a monthly GMP led partnership perpetrator and location disruption meeting. All this activity and the strategy is overseen by the multi-agency Complex Safeguarding Strategic Group which in turn reports into the Wigan Safeguarding Children's Executive.
